## 4 Tips for a Flawless Pixie

Got a pixie? Nicholas Penna, Jr., owner and lead stylist of SalonCapri in Newton and Denham, MA, shares his tips for maintaining the uber-short cut.

1. Get instantly edgy with spikes and twisted texture; to do, Penna recommends using Cotton Uzu and Shape Paste Frame Wax by Shu Uemura.
2. For a glam, glossy effect, apply straightening crème. You can also tease hair out with a little L'Oréal Professional Densiforce Mousse.
3. Amp up volume in fine hair by working in a lightweight mousse and blow-drying with a round ceramic brush.

## LIFT YEARS OFF YOUR LOOK!

Like an instant facelift, the right cut can make you look years younger! Let these tips from Romi Cortier of Los Angeles' Romi Cortier Design get you started.

- The jaw and neckline can be among the first to soften with age, so try to shift the focus toward your eyes by creating more lift higher up.

- Avoid any extremes when

it comes to bangs. Too short or extra-blunt fringe can look severe on women over the age of 40.

- Create more movement in your crop by keeping it soft. Even the slightest hint of asymmetry can work in your favor. The key is subtle—don't go overboard, cautions the stylist.

- Finally, think about how your profile looks. Keeping the nape tighter than the crown (translation: graduation) can help play up both your cheekbones and jawline. This makes the head appear rounder from the side and also lengthens the neck.
